

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



# **OPENING THE POLLS**

#### STEPS TO OPEN THE POLLS

- 1. Arrive at the polls promptly at 5:30 A.M. to make sure that the deputy custodian has opened the precinct. Call the Clerk of Court's office at **736-6394** if the deputy custodian is not there or if there is a problem..
- 2. Swear in your commissioners. If someone has failed to arrive, make replacements from your alternate list. Call the Clerk of Court's office if someone did not show up for work and you have no alternates on your list and you need a commissioner.
- 3. To open the voting machines, see detailed instructions for the **AVC ADVANTAGE**, "Opening the Polls" instructions on page 4 of the Election Day handout. **ALL VOTING MACHINES <u>MUST</u> BE OPENED**.
- 4. Open the voting machine with the precinct tag first. It contains the supplies and the precinct register. Have one commissioner get the Precinct Supply Envelope and verify that the supplies and forms are inside. Verify the ballot on each machine with the sample ballot from the supply envelope and the Official Zero Proof Report. Verify the time on the Zero Proof Report AT THE TIME IT PRINTS. Set your watch by this time. Call the Clerk of Court's office if there are any discrepancies.
- 5. Because every machine has been programmed with a cartridge, all machines must be opened and the results printed out.
- 6. The Commissioners should post the sample ballot, "Official Zero Proof Report" (for each machine), CARD OF INSTRUCTIONS, and "NOTICE TO VOTER" in a conspicuous place at the principle entrance to the polling place. Post the STOP SIGN on the outside of the precinct near the principle entrance.
- 7. Clear all political materials (signs, pamphlets, etc.) within 600 feet of the precinct, except those on PRIVATE property. Check throughout the day to make sure that the are within 600 feet is kept free from "electioneering" material. **NOTE:** 600 feet is the length of two football fields; it's more than a city block..
- 8. Verify any watchers by asking for their commissions and for photo identification. Compare the name on the identification with the name on the commission.
- 9. When the Supplemental list of <u>absentee voters</u> is delivered by a deputy clerk of court, print "Absentee" by the voter's name in the precinct register. Initial the notation. **These people shall not vote in person**.
- 10. When the Supplemental List of registered voters is delivered by a deputy clerk of court, put this in the front of the precinct register. If a voter's name is not found in the precinct register, look on the Supplemental List..
- 11. Have everything ready to go by 6:00 A.M. sharp.
- 12. MAKE SURE THAT YOU DO NOT ACTIVATE THE VOTING MACHINE UNTIL A VERIFIED VOTER APPROACHES THE MACHINE.

#### "A" KEY ENVELOPE

This envelope is delivered to the Commissioner-in-Charge by the Deputy Custodian by 5:30 A.M. on the morning of the election. COMPARE ALL NUMBERS ON THE ENVELOPE TO THE NUMBERS ON YOUR MACHINES. Back of "A" key envelope provides detailed instructions to guide you when opening the polls.

- FLUG IN THE FIRST MACHINE, DAISY CHAIN THE OTHERS TOGETHER, CHECK FOR THE AMBER AC POWER LIGHT ON EACH MACHINE.
- COMPLETE YOUR SECURITY CHECK. THE NUMBER ON THE SIDE OF THE MACHINE SHOULD MATCH THE NUMBER ON THE KEY CHAIN. THE SEAL NUMBER ON THE ENVELOPE THAT HELD YOUR KEYS SHOULD MATCH THE SEAL ON THE BLUE RESULTS CARTRIDGE. IF EITHER DOESN'T MATCH IMMEDIATELY CALL THE VOTING MACHINE WAREHOUSE AT
- . ATTACH THE OPERATOR PANEL
- . TURN THE POWER SWITCH ON.
- RECORD THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER NUMBER AND THE SEAL NUMBER ON THE MACHINE CERTIFICATE.
- WITH THE SILVER POLLS KEY TURN TO THE OPEN POLLS POSITION AND REMOVE THE SILVER KEY. DO NOT USE IT AGAIN UNTIL TIME TO CLOSE THE POLLS. ZERO PROOF WILL BEGIN PRINTING.
- RAISE DON'T FORCE THE FACE OF THE MACHINE INTO AN UPRIGHT POSITION.
- TILT THE FACE OF THE MACHINE INTO THE VOTING POSITION BY USING THE RED LATCH RELEASE.
- UNLOCK THE FRONT WITH THE GOLD KEY AND UNFOLD THE BOOTH.
- . ATTACH THE CURTAIN ASSEMBLY,
- REVIEW THE ZERO PROOF REPORT FROM THE PRINTER, VERIFY IT, HAVE EACH COMMISSIONER SIGN IT, AND POST IT ON THE WALL.
- . CLOSE THE BACK DOOR AND LOCK IT WITH THE GOLD KEY.
- . SET UP ANY ADDITIONAL AVC MACHINES IN THE SAME MANNER.
- PLACE THE KEYS IN THE APPROPRIATE "B" ENVELOPE.
- POST THE SAMPLE BALLOT AND ANY SIGNS AND WAIT FOR THE VOTERS.
- FOR MACHINE PROBLEMS IMMEDIATELY CALL THE VOTING MACHINE WAREHOUSE AT





**PROTECTIVE COUNTER NUMBER** — this number indicates the number of votes that have been cast on that machine in its history of service in elections.







## NOTICE TO VOTERS

You must present a Louisiana driver's license, a Louisiana special identification card or other generally recognized picture ID in order to vote. If you do not have a picture ID, you may vote today after providing other identifying information and executing an affidavit to that effect. If you do not have a Louisiana driver's license, a free Louisiana special identification card can be obtained from the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of Motor Vehicles. Contact the Office of Motor Vehicles for further information.





#### SAMPLE SUPPLEMENTAL POLL (VOTER) LIST

Occasionally names are added to the voting rolls after the Precinct Register has been printed by the Registrar of Voters. The Supplemental Poll (Voter) List is to be attached by the commissioners to the front of the precinct register on election day. This list will be delivered by a deputy clerk of court on election day. If a voter comes in to vote and his name is not in the Precinct Register, check this list.






#### SAMPLE SUPPLEMENTAL ABSENTEE LIST

Occasionally the Registrar of Voters receives Absentee Ballots after the Precinct Registers have been closed and placed in the voting machines. The Supplemental Absentee List, delivered by a deputy clerk of court on election day, is to be opened IMMEDIATELY. Use this list to mark "absentee" by the corresponding names in the Precinct Register. If a voter comes in to vote and his name is on this list, the person shall not be allowed to vote.






#### **POLL WATCHERS**

All poll watchers and their alternates will be issued a Commission, like the one shown below, from the Clerk of Court. A Watcher commission will be blue. An Alternate Watcher commission will be yellow.


**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** A candidate **SHALL** be entitled to have both a watcher and an alternate watcher serve at the precinct on election day. But they shall NOT serve at the same time.



- 1. When an individual identifies himself as a poll watcher, a commissioner should ask the individual for their commission and some form of photo identification.
- 2. The commissioner should verify that the commission and the photo identification match.
- 3. Refer to the yellow "Informational Pamphlet" in your supply envelope for the powers and duties of a poll watcher.

# AFFIDAVITS USED AT THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY

#### **VOTER IDENTIFICATION AFFIDAVIT**

You are required to identify each voter by asking for a Louisiana driver's license, a Louisiana special identification card, or some other form of generally recognized picture identification. If a voter does not have a photo ID, he/she must provide further identification by presenting his/her current registration certificate, providing his/her date of birth, and providing other information stated in the precinct register that you request and he/she must execute a "VOTER IDENTIFICATION AFFIDAVIT," several of which are included in your supplies. Also, you will find in your supplies a "NOTICE TO VOTERS" which you must post with the other supplies and ballots that you are required to post.

NOTE: FAILURE OF A COMMISSIONER TO REQUITE THE VOTER TO SUBMIT A PICTURE ID OR IDENTIFICATION AND EXECUTE A VOTER IDENTIFICATION AFFIDAVIT CAN RESULT IN A FINE AND/OR IMPRISONMENT.

**CLERK'S NOTE:** If a voter does not have a picture ID, he/she must provide further information by answering questions regarding their date of birth and mother's maiden name, or other information as contained in the precinct register. If a voter provides you with a non-picture ID (i.e., voter registration card) they still must answer the required questions and complete the Voter Identification Affidavit (AV-34).

#### ADDRESS CONFIRMATION AT THE POLLS

#### \*\*\*NOTE TO COMMISSIONERS\*\*\*

If the applicant has checked BOX 3, you must pay careful attention. If the voter indicates that it has been MORE THAN 3 MONTHS since they have moved, that person may NOT vote under state law.

#### ADDRESS CONFIRMATION AT POLLS

TO COMMISSIONERS: This form is to be completed by a voter who is: (1) identified as an inactive voter on the precinct register; or (2) challenged on the basis that he or she no longer resides at the address where he or she is registered and the challenge is valid.

TO VOTER: If you are identified as an inactive voter, the registrar of voters has reason to believe that your address on file in his or her office is inaccurate. You were mailed an address confirmation card and have failed to respond. You are required to confirm your address at the polls today.

If you are a challenged voter you are required to confirm your address at the polls today since you were challenged on the basis that you no longer reside at the address where you are registered and the commissioners have determined that the challenge is valid.

Part I and Part II of this form must be completed. After completion, sign the form and return it to the commissioner.

PART I: You must check one of the boxes below. If Box 3 is checked, please provide all information requested.



#### SAMPLE PRECINCT REGISTER PAGE

When you see a notation in the register like the one shown below, the voter must complete the Address Confirmation at the Polls form. If the voter indicates that they moved **MORE THAN 3 MONTHS AGO**, state law does **NOT** allow them to vote in state or local elections. This person would, however, be allowed to cast a provisional paper ballot in a federal election.
